Approval of Requirement for Member Businesses to Notify the Central Nonprofit Agency if the Member is Suspended or Debarred

Proposed language:

The state or local public body may be prohibited from contracting with entities that have been suspended or disbarred by the State Purchasing Agent. The state or local public body may also be prohibited from contracting with entities that have been listed on the government wide exclusions in the System for Award Management (SAM) pursuant to the OMB guidelines at 2 CFR 180 that implement Executive Orders 12549 (3 CFR part 1986 Comp. p. 189) and 12689 (3 CFR part 1989 Comp., p. 235). The member affirms that it is not listed on the System for Award Management, and that it is not suspended or disbarred by the State Purchasing Agent. The member further agrees to immediately notify the state or local public body should it be listed on the System for Award Management or be suspended or disbarred by the State Purchasing Agent at any time during the term of work on behalf of the state or local public body. The state or local public body shall also monitor the System for Award Management and State Purchasing Agent suspension or debarment list, and any State Use Act contract shall be terminated immediately should the member be listed on the System for Award Management or State Purchasing Agent suspension or debarment list.
